

IRS Form W-2 Questions & Answers January 2024

Q: What is the IRS Form W-2?

A: The Form W-2 is a statement that all employers must furnish to individuals. The W-2 form reports an employee's annual wages and the amount of taxes withheld from the employee's paycheck.

Q: How do I access my Form W-2?

Login to my.Lakeland.edu (if you no longer have access - you should contact the help desk at 920-565-1143 or contact Tracy Moenning for a copy)
Click on "Employee Info" (in white print/black box in the blue header area)
Click on "Payroll Information" (off to the left)
The 2023 W-2 is available in "PDF Reports" (middle right area of the screen)

Q: What information is provided on Form W-2?

Q: I did not receive a Form W-2. Should I expect one?

A: If you were an employee of Lakeland University and earned wages during the calendar year 2023, you should expect a W-2. If no wages were earned, you won't receive a W-2.

If you are an individual or sole proprietor and you were paid \$600 or more by Lakeland University but were not a Lakeland employee, you will be issued Form 1099-MISC (or 1099-NEC) and will not receive a W-2.

Individuals paid by the institution may receive a W-2 or a 1099-MISC (or 1099-NEC) but not both unless circumstances required both.

Q: I am no longer an employee of Lakeland University. How will I receive Form W-2?

A: Your W-2 will be mailed to the permanent home address on file on or before January 31st.

Q: What do I do with this form?
